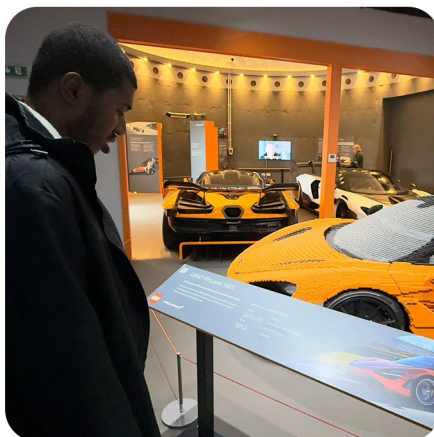

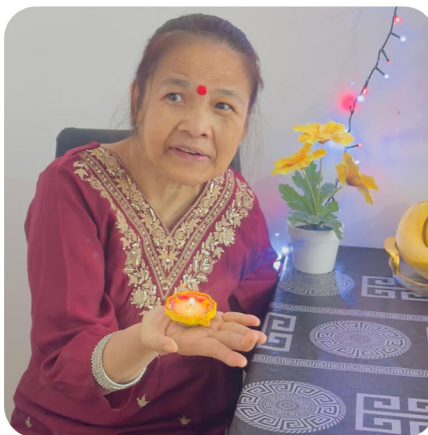
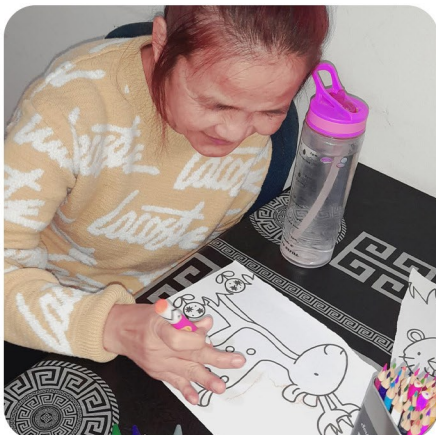

The celebrations of Diwali and Dashain brought everyone together with traditional food, decorations, and cultural sharing, creating a joyful and festive atmosphere.



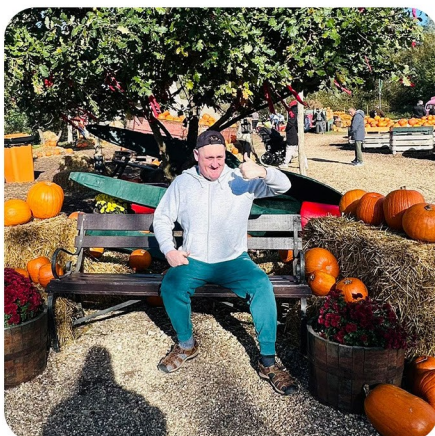

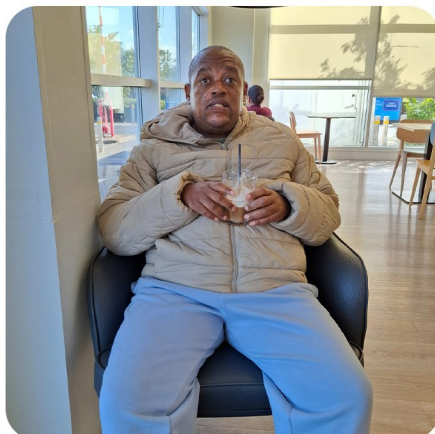
